EDUCATION PLUS! Funding Creative Classroom Projects

The Education PLUS! Fund at Coastal Community Foundation was established in 1990 by retired educators to support educational programs in the North Coastal public schools. Grants between \$250 and \$1,000 are provided for math and science instruction, real world applications of classroom learning, language enhancement, music, creative and performing arts programs. In spring numerous classroom projects were funded.

Third graders at Jefferson Elementary participated in the Telescope Project. The program is designed to help students understand technology and its impact on scientific discoveries. In addition to classroom time, each student was able to check out a telescope to share with their families for the night.

Del Rio Elementary received funds to purchase costumes and props for educational plays for the second grade students. "Teaching tools such as these are now considered "extras" due to the budget crisis, and requests for such items have been turned down due to limited funding," stated the principal.
