



2019 Land Management Internship

Conservancy Biologists will mentor the Land Management Intern in land monitoring activities in and near San Elijo Lagoon Ecological Reserve in Encinitas, CA. This volunteer internship requires a 30 hour per week commitment. We offer this internship in our summer session only.

The Land Management Intern will spend approximately 50% of their time in the field. Field learning includes GPS-enabled mapping, photo monitoring, and recording data for Conservancy fee titles and conservation easements. The Land Management Intern will spend approximately 50% of their time at San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy's office in Solana Beach, CA. Office learning includes GIS and other database management duties, report writing, and correspondence.

Learning Objectives

- Know how to utilize GIS software to prepare maps and download new data
- Understand how to manage fee title lands and conservation easements
- Further plant identification skills
- Gain field experience in vegetation mapping and monitoring

Who should apply?

Applicants who have a strong interest in natural lands management and environmental concerns. Experience with GIS software and plant identification a plus. Applicants must have their own transportation and be comfortable performing work in outdoor conditions.
