



## **2019 Conservation Education Internship**

Conservancy Education Manager will mentor the Conservation Education Intern to connect, educate, and engage the community to act to ensure the health and wellbeing of their watershed. This volunteer internship requires a 10-12 hour per week commitment. We offer this internship in our spring, summer and fall sessions.

The Conservation Education Intern will spend approximately 50% of their time in the field. Field learning includes assisting with school programs by engaging students in science practices. The Conservation Education Intern will spend approximately 50% of their time at San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy's office located in Solana Beach, CA. Office learning includes developing hands-on environmental activities for school and public programs, and uploading data and photos into the databases.

### **Learning Objectives**

- Learn how to enhance K-12 student field experiences by asking questions and exploring the natural world
- Learn from Next Generation Science Standards - trained educators and naturalists

### **Who should apply?**

Applicants who have a strong interest in conservation education and environmental concerns. Applicants must have their own transportation and be comfortable performing work in outdoor conditions. Availability must a minimum of two weekdays (Tuesday-Friday) 8:30 am-12:30 pm
