Holiday Guided Walks at San Elijo Lagoon

Saturdays: **December 20, 27 & January 3** from 10-11 a.m.;

Sunday, **December 21** from 3-4 pm

San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center Loop Trail*

Visitors to San Elijo Lagoon will enjoy the colors of the season: red berries of the green toyon and white-flowering coyote brush. Cooler days herald the arrival of migratory birds. They wade, hover, hunt, and rest in the salt marsh and mudflat habitats upon which they depend. This is life between the tides at one of San Diego's largest coastal wetlands. You might see mullet splash from the water. Glimpse Osprey and Egrets hunting fish and invertebrates in the salt marsh. Free. All ages.
