Lagoon Discovery Camps Engage a Sense of Wonder

Youth Can Explore the World of Wetlands Beginning with Spring Camp in April

Cardiff-by-the-Sea—San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy announces open registration for its Lagoon Discovery Camps this spring and summer. Camps are designed to encourage youth to explore the diversity of plants and animals that live in coastal estuaries—like San Elijo Lagoon.

Lagoon Discovery Camps

Campers will delight in fine-tuning their senses in nature. Kids (ages 6-9) will observe plant and animal life by hearing, seeing, smelling, touching—even tasting nature. Interactive activities include live animal encounters, learning to identify animal tracks, and making paper from recycled and natural materials. Participants will also enjoy discovery hikes, playing games, and journaling. Camps are led by conservancy-trained docents and staff and take place at the San Elijo Lagoon Nature Center, located at 2710 Manchester Avenue in Cardiff-by-the-Sea.

Cost: \$150/child (\$125 by March 15)

Camps are limited to 16 participants per session and are expected to sell out. A limited number of scholarships are available for families with demonstrated need.
